2007 RULE UPDATES:

ALL LLAMAS ARE ELIGIBLE to enter these shows, whether CLAA registered or not.

COSTUME CLASSES are now eligible for sanctioned points. A Costume Championship is earned with 15 points and a Supreme Costume Championship with 30 points.

AWARD OF MERIT – with the addition of sanctioned Costume Classes, points to earn an Award Of Merit have been increased to 20.

ENTRY FEES:

Halter Classes: \$ 20
Showmanship: \$ 5
Fleece Classes: \$ 10
Performance Classes: \$ 10
Costume Classes and handlers under 8 years: no fee but entry must be made.

PENNING: Penning will be done out of trailer.

VETERINARIAN ON CALL: Humboldt Vet Services 306-682-5544

FLEECES IN/OUT: Fleeces must be delivered to the Fleece Steward by 10 AM, August 19, 2007. Fleeces may be picked up after the show. Exhibitors having fleeces delivered must give clear instructions and fees for return of fleeces.

EXTRA AWARDS (selected from all eligible entries, no entry required):

Highest Qualifying Score in any Performance Class (Obstacle, or Pack)

Versatility Award, to the llama/handler team accumulating the most points in the following: one of Obstacle /Pack PLUS one of Halter /Fleece PLUS one of Showmanship/ Costume.

Youth Versatility Award, to the team (handler under 18 years) accumulating the most points in the following: three of Showmanship, Costume, Obstacle, and Pack.

MOVING UP: If a llama receives its third Qualifying score in an Obstacle or Pack Level at this show, upon payment of an additional entry fee, that animal may

"move up" and compete in the next Level at this show if there is judging time available. For instance, Fluffy is entered in Level 1 Obstacle. She already has 2 legs from previous shows. She earns her 3rd at this show. Her owner may pay an extra entry fee so Fluffy can compete in Obstacle Level Two at the same show.

DRESS CODE: Safe footwear is a requirement (no sandals or open-toed shoes will be allowed).

WHAT CLASS TO ENTER:

Juvenile llamas: over 5 and under 12 months on the day of the show.

Yearling llamas: 12 months and under 24 months on the show day.

Adult llamas: over 24 months on the day of the show.

Non-breeding llamas: vasectomized males and spayed females with a veterinary certificate of non-breeding status AND/OR animals registered as non-breeding AND/OR gelded males.

Light fibre: minimal body fibre; short neck fibre, smooth head, legs and ears. Judged 100% on conformation.

Medium fibre: moderate to long body fibre, minimal to moderate neck fibre, smooth to moderate head, legs and ear fibre. Judged 80% on conformation and 20% on fibre.

Heavy fibre: abundant fibre on body, neck, ears, legs and head. Judged 80% conformation and 20% on fibre.

Get of Sire: the sire is the entry but is not shown, nor need he be present. 3 offspring from at least 2 different dams are shown in the ring. All offspring must also have been shown in their respective halter classes.

Produce of Dam: the dam is the entry but is not shown, nor need she be present. 2 offspring are shown in the ring. All offspring must have been shown in their halter classes.

Fleece entries: entire skirted blanket only including shoulder, barrel and hip in a clear plastic bag.

First Shearing (llama must be 15 months or less at shearing)

Second Shearing (no more than 15 months' growth)

Successive Shearings (no more than 15 months' growth)

PeeWee handlers: under 8 years on the day of the show. Demonstration classes only. They are not judged.

Junior handlers: 6 years and under 11 years on the day of the show. Handlers 6-7 may enter PeeWee OR Junior.

Intermediate handlers: 11 years and under 13 years on the day of the show.

Senior handlers: 13 years and under 18 years on the day of the show.

Adult handlers: 18 years and older on the day of the show.

Level One: open to all llamas that have not earned a Level 1 title (3 qualifying L1 legs under at least 2 judges) in that sport.

Level Two: open to all llamas that have earned a Level 1 title in that sport

Level Three: open to all llamas that have earned a Level 2 title (3 qualifying L2 legs under at least 2 judges) in that sport.

SMOKING/ALCOHOL: There will be absolutely no smoking or consumption of alcohol allowed in the ring or around the trailer site.

The Saskatchewan Llama Association will use due care and diligence to ensure the safety and welfare of participants, but will not be held responsible in the event of mishaps.
